

NOTICE OF COLLECTION
to students and employees of the
Department of Forensic Science, Laurentian University

The **Department of Forensic Science**, Laurentian University, collects and uses personal information of students, employees, alumni and other parties, under the authority of *The Laurentian University of Sudbury Act, 1960*.

Personal information collected is needed by the **Department of Forensic Science**, Laurentian University, and used for the purposes of executing various functions and activities related to:

- a) Recruitment, administration, admissions, registration, academic advising, academic progression, graduation, convocation, academic programs, university-related student activities and services, recreation, awards and scholarships, employment, employee-related services, research and statistical reporting, **and other activities related to being a member of the University community and a user of services provided by the University.**
- b) All teaching members' professional development, where students' personal information may be included in the members' CVs, web pages, various applications and other reports the members may develop and utilize in the advancement of their research and their career.

The **Department of Forensic Science**, Laurentian University, assumes that by registering in a course or a program or accepting employment or a Post-Doctoral position with the University, a person has agreed to the conditions of the collection, use and disclosure of personal information contained in this Notice.
